## PARTICIPATION

This tournament is open to all members of youth bowling clubs with a bowling license which are registered with the Dutch Bowling Federation or are members of their National Association, IBF (International Bowling Federation) pupils and/or junior status up to 25 years. (NBF rules 527 applies):

*Article 527. Conditions for participation: 1. Participation in tournaments to which a NBF-sanction has been granted, is only permitted to members in possession of a valid, personal, bowling pass by the NBF issued and to members of foreign federations that are connected at the WTBA, in the possession of a valid proof of a membership at the WTBA connected bowling Federation and/or international bowling pass, and/or a valid game licence (letter of authorisation)*  
*3. The participation must also be refused to those who can not identify themselves in any way. The bowling pass referred to in Article 306 may serve as proof of identity.*  
*4. The organization has the right to refuse registration of a player.*

## FORMAT

### PRELIMINARY ROUNDS:

Entry en re-entry : Category 1 up to 6 play 6 games preliminary round, Amerikaans style, 2 players per lane.

### DESPERADO:

1 game, immediately after the final qualifying squad. Lanes will not be re-dressed for the Desperado Squad, and there will be no lane alternation, i.e. desperado athletes will bowl all ten frames on the same lane. Registration for desperado 45 minutes before start, first come first served. Number of places available 20.

### QUARTER FINALS:

Category 1 up to 6 play 4 games, Amerikaans style, 2 players per lane, 50% from the preliminary rounds (incl. Desperado) with a max. of 10 players qualify. 9 players directly, 10th from the Desperado. Scores from the preliminary rounds (category mixed 1 ladies bouns included) are carry forward.

### SEMI FINALS:

Top 4 from category 1 up to 6 play 3 games Round Robin, American style, 1 player per lane, scores from scratch.

#### **Bonus per game played Round Robin (including bonus ladies mixed class 1):**

game won 20 pins,  
drawn game: 10 pins,  
lost game: 0 pins

#### **Additional bonus Rounds Robin per game played (excluding bonus ladies mixed class 1):**

Men's game from 225: 15 pins, Women's game from 200: 15 pins,  
Men's game of 250 or higher: 20 pins, Women's game of 225 or higher 20 pins

### FINALS:

Top 4 category 1 up to 6 play 1 finals game, American style, 1 player per lane, scores carry forward out of Round Robin finals

#### **Additional bonus (incl. bonus ladies mixed class 1):**

**finished first - 100 pins, second - 60 pins, third - 20 pins, fourth - 0 pins**

## REGISTRATION

An athlete cannot, regardless the moment of cancellation, cancel a registration on behalf of another athlete, i.e. an athlete must cancel his/her booking personally.

An athlete cannot forward pre-ordered registrations to another athlete. Each athlete, who signs up, is considered a new athlete and will be positioned as the last registered athlete in that particular registered squad. Exception to this rule: in case the organiser has accepted a group booking of a national team and within this team another player is exchanged.

## SQUADS FORMATS:

### SQUAD CRITERIA AND CLASSIFICATION

Foreign participants living outside a radius of 250 km (155 Miles) from the bowling alley, are primarily playing their entry/re-entry in the last weekend before the finals on Sunday May 8th 2022.

The above rule applies up to 1 week before the start of the tournament. For available open spaces, after this date, everyone can enroll.

**After registration shifts to another series are no longer possible. If a registration is cancelled a new registration can not be re-registered.**

The series of the first weekend are generally reserved for participants from the Netherlands and Belgium.

Requested squads (both entry and re-entry) will be awarded as far as possible, if a required squad is full it cannot be booked.

Lane assignment is determined by the organisation.

## COACHING

Bowlers should indicate, at registration, whether they are using a trainer/coach. The trainer/coach must be certified.

## RE-ENTRY

Is only allowed once! Participants may indicate this at registration.

During the tournament this is only possible if there is still room in squads.

A player, who made a reservation for a re-entry, will be obligated to pay for this re-entry.

Should you decide not to play a re-entry after the first preliminary round, you will not receive any money back.

For all National and International participants, the score of the entry and re-entry will be passed to the NBF.

## SUBSCRIPTION AND PAYMENT TOURNAMENT

Participants who have subscribed or have had been subscribed are obliged at all times to pay his/her entry at subscription.

Any re-entry registered will be paid at the subscription of the squad to be played.

Payment **ONLY** in cash: starting 1 hour before the start of any series.

Please pay the exact amount of money as change is not available.

## CONFIRMATION OF REGISTRATION

All registrations made on the website: [www.juniordutchopen.com](http://www.juniordutchopen.com) will automatically be sent a certificate of registration by e-mail.

The organisation will try to fulfil the wishes of the requested series as much as possible.

The final squad assignment will be posted on the site no later than one week before the start of the tournament.

## PRESENCE

Players must register at least HALF HOURS before the start of their squads and finals at the tournament secretariat.

Late players shall start their game at the frame of the game following the last frame completed by their direct opponent.

The frames, games and/or matches, not played by the late player, cannot be made up and will be scored 0 (zero). (Article 226 NBF sporting regulations)

## NO SHOW

"No Show", which means that a player does not appear without having informed the organiser, or if the player informs the organiser after the start of the squad(s) for which the participant has registered.

## SANCTIONS "NO SHOW"

A player who cancels, does not show up in time ("No Show") will be reported to the disciplinary body of the Dutch Bowling Federation and/or ETBF.

The Organiser may issue a fine to the player in an amount equal to the maximum rate for an entry plus the maximum rate for a re-entry.

Penalty invoices for late cancellation(s) must be sent by the organiser no later than 7 days after the last day of the tournament.

## ATHLETES PULL OUTS

If a player, without the permission of the tournament management, in a squad: (entry or re-entry) leaves the tournament before having completed all games (illegal exit), all previous scores of this player are counted as zero. The player cannot re-enter the tournament in one of the later squads. If the player leaves the tournament during the final before he has completed all games of his final (illegal exit), all previous scores of the player are counted as zero.

In case of illegal quitting, any prizes won will not be refunded.

In case of legal quitting (allowed by the competition/tournament management), the player is not allowed to participate in any of the other series still to be played.

## OPEN FINAL POSITIONS will not be filled - NBF art. 528.

In accordance with Article 528, NBF Sporting Regulations, final positions that have fallen vacant will not be filled.

*Art. 528. Participation in finals: Participation in a final event depends on the score obtained in one or more previous events and is allowed only to those players who, by virtue of that score, have directly qualified for that final event. If a finalist is unable to participate in a final event, his place may not be taken by a player who did not originally qualify as a finalist, unless the tournament rules explicitly state that if a player withdraws before the start of the final, the final place will be filled.*

## The Sportsmanship Award:

## TOURNAMENT RULES

### RULES

The general playing and tournament rules of both the Dutch Bowling Federation (NBF Sporting Regulations) and ETBF will govern this tournament

### ORGANISATION

The Junior Dutch Open is organised by the Youth Department of Bowling Vereniging Leiden Zuid-West with the support of their Board, a group of enthusiastic volunteers and team Bowling Menken.

### SANCTIONED

This tournament is sanctioned by the Dutch Bowling Federation: Sanction No. 2022/A916 and European Tenpin Bowling Federation.

### HIGH FIVE:

- 1: I watch my language
- 2: I have fun first
- 3: I have respect for others
- 4: I deal neatly with the material
- 5: I set a good example.

### RESPONSIBILITY:

**Players, coaches, parents and/or supervisors** are responsible for ensuring that the bowling equipment does not pose a danger to other players or those present in the bowling centre. The organisation is not responsible for any loss or damage to bowling equipment or related items.

**Important : It is not allowed to bring and consume own drinks and food within the bowling center.**

The tournament organization, volunteers, players, coaches and trainers who are inside the players and/or coaching room are expected not to use alcohol or tobacco during the squads and/or finals to be played.

It is not allowed to eat or drink in the players' area.

### PLAYERS' AREA - COACHING

Upon registration, players indicate whether they will be using a trainer/coach. This trainer/coach is certified. In case of doubt, the organisation can ask for a licence or certificate.

Others than players and tournament officials are not allowed to be in the players' area prior to and during squads and finals.

The players' area is defined as the area from the start of the approach up to and including the walkway behind the players' seating area.

Coaches: who are registered and certified will receive a badge to be recognised by the organisers and match officials.

## BOWLING LICENSE AND AVERAGE

Reference date bowling licence age is September 1st 2021.

For players who are exclusively members of the NBF, the average on the (digital) **bowling license 2021-2022** is decisive. This shall be shown digitally and/or as a printout. In case no average is mentioned on the pass an official statement has to be presented in which the average of at least 21 games is mentioned. This statement may not be older than 14 days, the date of issue is mentioned on it.

For players who are member of the BBSF and/or the DBU and have participated in Dutch tournaments before, the tournament averages as determined by the NBF for the season 2021-2022 shall apply. If no data are known, the average on the bowling card of the federation concerned shall apply, provided it is calculated over at least 21 games. For players who are member of more than one federation, the highest pass average will be used.

If required, an identification document must be presented to confirm the date of birth.

If no bowling license with pass average from the National Bowling Federation of any country can be shown at registration, the player concerned will play in the highest class.

Players who wish to play in a higher class must state this at the time of registration. A player may play a maximum of 1 category higher.

## TIE

In case of a tie after the preliminary rounds, the player with the highest last game including bonus will proceed to the quarter finals. If this is also equal, the second last game applies, etc. etc.

In case of a possible tie in the quarter finals, a ninth and tenth frame shall be played between the tied players in order to qualify for the next semi-final or final, after which the highest score over these 2 frames shall entitle the player to the higher position, until a decision has been made.

*NBF rule art. 218-1-2-3 paragraph c.: Ex aequo preliminaries, quarter-final, semi-final and final:*

1. When 2 or more players tie in a match, the order of these players is determined by the total pinfall (scratch) achieved by these players over all the games of this match.
2. The player with the highest last game is assigned the higher position.
3. If the decision rule mentioned in paragraph 1 is not successful, the final ranking can be determined as follows: c) the tied players play a ninth and tenth frame, after which the highest score over these 2 frames gives the right to the higher position; all this until a decision is made. "a"

## CHECKING THE SCORES

Any complaint about the correctness of the scores must be made to the tournament management within 10 minutes of the official announcement.

## NO UNNECESSARY DELAY DURING SQUADS AND FINALS

After the player to your right and/or left has left the approach, you must start your own throw within 30 seconds, in order to avoid unnecessary delay, in accordance with the NBF Sanctions Policy, Art. 224, paragraph 3 and 225, paragraph 1 and Art. 241 Sanctions.

## DRESSING CODE

The wearing of bowling clothes is mandatory, during the entire tournament as well as with the prize-giving ceremony. The clothing for players and coaches must always be in accordance with the tournament rules.

Wearing jeans, jogging clothes and caps in any form is not allowed.

If you have a medical or demonstrable reason you can discuss it with the tournament leader.

Organisation and volunteers will set a good example and wear appropriate clothing throughout the tournament.

## **PHONE / TABLETS / PHOTO / FILM / VIDEO WEBLOG (VLOG):**

The use of mobile (smart) phones, Ipads, tablets (must be switched off) by participants is not allowed during the entire tournament in and behind the players' area.

## **CODE OF CONDUCT: JUNIOR DUTCH OPEN AND NBF**

## **LANE CONDITIONS / PLAYING CONDITIONS**

During the tournament a playing pattern will be laid down which is easy to play on, but gives some challenge.

## **AWARD CEREMONY - INDIVIDUAL PRIZES - TROPHIES**

In the individual ranking the top four players of all classes of the 1st JUNIOR DUTCH OPEN TOERNOOI are eligible for a podium place.

Prizewinners have to be present at the award ceremony.

Prizes will not be handed out prematurely unless it can be proved that for example a flight has to be caught or that the winner has to leave the tournament due to unforeseen circumstances.

The finalist, who does not participate in a final event, is not entitled to the prize that is connected to the position in the final ranking that he has after that final event. This prize will be forfeited to the organisation. In accordance with NBF sport regulation article 538, use of prize money, paragraph 4

## **DECISION-MAKING**

In all cases not provided for in these rules, the tournament management will decide.

This decision is irrevocable and no discussion is possible.
